## POINTS SCORING SYSTEM 2024

At the close of the Stableford competition and using the competition results sheet generated by the host club's competition software, the best 3 scores from each team will be used for the calculation of team points as followed: -

Once 3 members of a club's team have been awarded team points, other players' scores from that team will not be considered. Points continue to be awarded until all available points have been allocated to those within the points range ( 12 points down to 1 point or 10 points down to 1 point).

If a player is a member of more than one club, the Host J/O must make sure that the player \& points are assigned to the MCJL club that they are representing. Please make a note of this on the competition results sheet when reporting the results by email (see below).

Any scores over 42 points should be highlighted to the player's club so that the player's handicap may be monitored by its JO and the club's Handicap Committee.

## TIE-BREAK SYSTEM

Should two or more clubs finish with the same number of league points after all rounds have been completed, a tie-break system will be used to determine the winner. The tie-break will use the aggregate of the Stableford scores achieved by the 3 best players for each club at each venue for the ENTIRE season. If the tie-break is needed, there will be a cap of 42 points on the maximum individual Stableford score achieved. If clubs have only been able to field 1 or 2 players at a fixture, the lowest score achieved that day will be credited to their team score.
